Requirements for the design of the article

The text of the article not **more than 5 pages** should be typed in Microsoft Word, font Times New Roman 12, line spacing - single, format A 4, all margins: 2 cm. Red line indentation - 1.25. Alignment of the text of the article on the width of the page. Save in the format .doc.

At the top right indicate the number and name of the section, author's full name, course, faculty (or department), name of the supervisor, name of the university;

On one line in the centre, the title of the report in **bold** CAPITAL letters. After 1 interval - the abstract of the article (up to 5 sentences) and key words (up to 5 words) in *italics*. Then the main text begins 1 spacing;

References to the source should be placed in square brackets [] after the citation. Do not use automatic numbering. The list of references is obligatory and is given at the end of the article; Tables, schemes, diagrams and figures are inserted in figure format. Inscriptions in the figure should be in black and white, readable.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject articles that do not meet the design requirements. Articles are not peer-reviewed, the authors are responsible for the content of submitted articles and for forms of unauthorised borrowing (plagiarism).

Materials should be submitted until 15 April 2024 inclusive to the following e-mail address:




Figure 1: Graphics
